Community Outreach: iThembehihle LSEN - Aug 2015

As part of our Cub Challenge 2015, we were challenged to find a school that we could partner with and help were we could. We chose iThembehihle LSEN in Primrose. The school was initially established to cater for the needs of various children who are physically disabled. Admitted children include those with athrogryposis, cerebral palsy, muscular dystrophy, phocomelia, poliomyelitis, and spinal difida, as well as amputees. These children are admitted to the school by doctors, social workers, teachers and parents.

The boarding school is partially state-aided, whilst it mostly relies on support from private entities for the majority of its requirements.

There are currently 208 children ranging from ages 5 to 14 in the boarding school. The essential goal of the school is to equip each child with a well-rounded academic, life, and physical education of the highest possible quality, ensuring optimal development and utilization of all talents and enabling them to integrate themselves into mainstream society.

We established areas that we could help the school for this year including items that the children required and a visit with fun activities planned.

Our cubs donated 70 (Hand knotted) blankets, 30 duvet inners and covers, DVDs, pajamas, clothes, games, puzzles, storage containers and soccer balls.

We visited the school on the 7 August and enjoyed fun activities with the boarding school children. Our cubs interacted so well and finished off the day with hot chocolate, extra treats (thanks to the St Benedict's grade 4 cake and candy left overs!) and a whole lot of singing!

Thank you to all the cubs – you are so very special! And a special thank you to all the cub mommies for volunteering their time and energy into this very special cause!
